But this positive reception for artificial intelligence is not evenly distributed, with a clear gap emerging between managerial and non-managerial employees. While 71% of UAE managers say their use of data in daily work has increased over past five years and 73% believe their use of data will continue to increase over the next five years, only 44% of non-managers say they have used more data over the same period and a mere third expect to use more in the coming five years.

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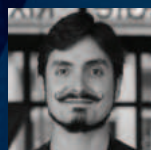
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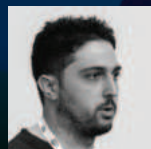
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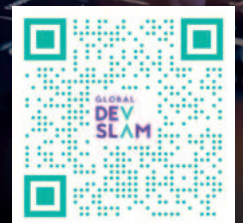
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
